Introduction

Welcome to this exhibition at Redwood Café, showcasing digital landscape artworks by local artist Miki Shaw. Her work focuses on the familiar places she loves around Finchley and Barnet, created through a process she describes as painting with light - digital painting with a limited palette, built up layer by layer to re-imagine everyday scenes.

The Artworks

Riverside Walk

A view of the winding wooded pathways along Dollis Brook.

Finchley Squared

A composition celebrating favourite Finchley landmarks: Riverside Walk & Dollis Brook, Stephens House & Gardens, the East Finchley Archer, Finchley Lido Leisure Centre, the King Edward Hall clock tower, Victoria Park, and The Tally Ho.

Stephen's House and Gardens

A well-loved local landmark dating back to 1882, built as the home of Henry "Inky" Stephens.

Swan Lane Open Space

Created especially for this exhibition, inspired by the park Miki often visits with her children and the way its light changes through the seasons.

King Edward Hall clock tower

Finchley Central's clock tower, built in 1911.

The Archer

A tribute to East Finchley's 1940s iconic statue.

About the artist

Miki Shaw is an artist, illustrator and designer working across digital art, community projects and creative education. Her background spans computer science, animation, fine art and graphic design, and she has created visual work for schools, festivals, live performances and arts organisations in the UK and beyond. She also leads workshops for children and adults and develops personal work exploring everyday places and family life.
